IMPORTANT SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR CHURCH (NEW)

These guidelines have been temporarily implemented to make our church environment safer.

1. All pews on the left side are available. Only pews on right side with ribbons are to be used.
2. Pews should have 3 people per pew - one on each end and one in the middle, or two on one end (husband/ wife, etc.) and one on the other end. If there is a family group, they may all be seated in the same pew. PLEASE WORK WITH US ON THIS.
3. In case the sanctuary becomes filled, please find a seat in the fellowship hall or balcony. We ask people using the balcony be vaccinated.
4. We will not take the offering during the service. Place your envelope in the offering plate located in the narthex or in the fellowship hall.
5. Please use either the main church doors to exit, or use the wide entrance into the fellowship hall. If you are seated in the fellowship hall, please exit using the glass doors by the library.

AS WE GATHER: "Some of the most memorable portraits of Jesus shared with us by the Gospel writers depict times when He prayed. We remember Him teaching the disciples to pray when He was on the mountain, sharing the heart of His teaching. We have the powerful portrait of Him praying in the Garden of Gethsemane the night He was betrayed. And in John's Gospel is recorded what is known as the High Priestly Prayer of our Lord. Jesus prayed for His people during His earthly ministry; He continues that praying for us. In his first epistle, John writes that "we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous" (1 John 2:1). There is holy conversation in heaven just as sure as there is holy conversation on earth when we pray!

REMEMBERING DR WALTHER: The Rev. Dr. C.F.W. Walther (Oct. 25, 1811 – May 7, 1887) served as the first president of the LCMS, founded in 1847. As a young pastor, Walther joined the Saxon Germans who immigrated to the US in 1839, and, at 27 years old, he was the leader of the group that settled in Perry County, Mo. He served as president from 1847 to 1850 and again from 1864 to 1878.

Walther presided over the young Synod, leading its growth through the years of the great migration of German immigrants. He served as president of Concordia Seminary from 1850 to 1887, and was editor of *Der Lutheraner*, a leading magazine of the day.

Today, Walther is revered as the leading Lutheran theologian of his time, and he's fondly known as the "Father of the Missouri Synod."

Western PA is blessed to have a special local connection since Walther's great-great grandson is Jim Wolf, a member of Peace Lutheran Church in McMurray.
