IMPORTANT SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR CHURCH (NEW)

These guidelines have been temporarily implemented to make our church environment safer.

1. Pews should have 3 people per pew - one on each end and one in the middle, or two on one end (husband/ wife, etc.) and one on the other end. If there is a family group, they may all be seated in the same pew. PLEASE WORK WITH US ON THIS.
2. In case the sanctuary becomes filled, please find a seat in the fellowship hall or balcony.
3. We will not take the offering during the service. Place your envelope in the offering plate located in the narthex or in the fellowship hall.

BULLETINS, SERMONS AND LIVE WORSHIP: Bulletins and sermons are available for viewing and download on our website. A live stream of worship services is available on our Facebook page. HOME COMMUNION: Christ Lutheran is providing Home Communion Packages with individually wrapped wafers and wine cups.
