IMPORTANT SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR CHURCH

These guidelines have been temporarily implemented to make our church environment safer.

1. Pews should have 3 people per pew - one on each end and one in the middle, or two on one end (husband/ wife, etc.) and one on the other end. If there is a family group, they may all be seated in the same pew. PLEASE WORK WITH US ON THIS.
2. In case the sanctuary becomes filled, please find a seat in the fellowship hall or balcony.
3. We will not take the offering during the service. Place your envelope in the offering plate located in the narthex or in the fellowship hall.

BULLETINS, SERMONS AND LIVE WORSHIP: Bulletins and sermons are available for viewing and download on our website. A live stream of worship services is available on our Facebook page. HOME COMMUNION: Christ Lutheran is providing Home Communion Packages with individually wrapped wafers and wine cups. These packages are to be distributed to those who are institutionalized or remain at home on Sundays. Your help getting these packages out is needed. Talk to Pastor if you'd like to help.

GOLF: 17th Annual Concordia Golf Classic was a Tee-riffic Success! This year marked the 17th annual golf outing at the Treesdale Golf and Country Club. Over 180 golfers played a great round to support the Good Samaritan Endowment Fund, our charitable care fund that helps offset the cost of care for residents who have outlived their resources. We're thrilled to say that nearly \$130,000 in net proceeds were raised for the Good Samaritan Endowment Fund!

FESTIVAL: Thanks to our amazing team and the Concordia at Cabot community – this year's festival exceeded all of our expectations! Between 700-800 residents, families, friends and community members came. In addition to the mini-fishing derby for kids, crafts, games, a caricature artist, bounce slide and live music and hosted a car show featuring over 50 cars from Ford Model Ts to Corvettes. The traditional worship service was led by Pastor Jack Hartman and included a 30-plus-member choir of Concordia staff, friends, family members, residents and board members.

After 10 o'clock the sky cleared and we were able to celebrate our Festival in the woods in beautiful weather. The attendance was not as great as usual, because of the rain, but it was a beautiful Festival. Pastor Lothmann of Akron, OH, preached in the morning and Pastor Walz in the afternoon. Pastor Huegli preached in English.
