NEW LOGO: The new logo for the Eastern District of the LCMS is a simple cross because we have a simple, yet profound message to share: God has saved the world through Jesus'

death and resurrection. The yellow and pink shapes at the bottom of the cross symbolize

the fire of the Holy Spirit that appeared over the heads of the disciples on the Day of Pentecost. This same Spirit enlightens and sanctifies the whole Christian Church today. The pink and purple hues transition to blue hues toward the top of the cross. These shapes and colors symbolize the flowing Baptismal waters that bring forgiveness and a new identity to God's people. All of the shapes within the cross also resemble a topographical map highlighting hills and valleys. The Eastern District includes Lake Erie, Lake Ontario, Niagara Falls, the Finger Lakes, the Appalachian Mountains, and other beautiful sights in God's creation. The Church gathers in places all over the Eastern District to proclaim the message of the cross to a world in need of Jesus. Christ Lutheran is a member of this district.

As we gather for worship, we gather around God's Word and God's Meal—the Lord's Supper.
