IMPORTANT SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR CHURCH

These guidelines have been temporarily implemented to make our church environment safer.

1. Only every other pew will be used. You will be ushered to a pew when you enter the sanctuary. Pews will be filled from the front of the church to the back, so you might not be ushered to your favorite pew. We ask your patience as we adjust to this new situation. Pews will have 3 people per pew - one on each end and one in the middle, or two on one end (husband/ wife, etc.) and one on the other end. If there is a family group, they will all be seated in the same pew. PLEASE WORK WITH US ON THIS.
2. Bulletins will already be placed on your pew.
3. The seating capacity of the sanctuary will be limited to approximately 40 people. In case it becomes filled, there will be 5 or 6 seats available in the balcony and chairs will be available in the fellowship hall.
4. We will not take the offering during the service. Place your envelope in the offering plate located in the narthex and in the fellowship hall.

Leaving the Building 1. You will be ushered out of the sanctuary when the service is over. Ushering will start at the back. Please remain in your pew until it's your turn to exit. You will not be ushered out if you are in the balcony or the fellowship hall. If you are seated in either of those locations, please observe social distancing when you talk with others and exit the building.

2. If you are seated in the sanctuary or upstairs, please use either the main church doors to exit, or use the wide entrance into the fellowship hall. If you are seated in the fellowship hall, please exit using the glass doors by the library. Please do not use the narrow hallway with the coat rack.

PERICOPE BIBLE STUDY: All who are interested may attend the Bible study that has resumed in the library. They will meet at 8:45am on Sunday mornings.

FELLOWSHIP HALL BIBLE STUDY: The Bible study led by Barry Schoenthal is set to resume on Sept. 13 at 9am. They will resume study of the books of prophesy of Habakkuk and Zephaniah. You are invited (former and new members who would like to study these Old Testament books to join him and his group in the Fellowship Hall.

CHILDREN'S BIBLE CLASSES: Pre school and elementary aged in person Bible classes will begin also on Sept. 13 at 9am.

WELCOME VISITORS! Please fill out a Welcome Card (located in the card holders in pews) and give to Pastor after the service and receive a special welcome gift. Children's bulletins and activity bags are available at the church entrance. A mother's room and restroom are located at the left rear of the church. If you do not have a church home, you are warmly invited to join with us.

AS WE GATHER: God's people have gifts that are signs of His loving presence and demonstrations of His gracious power. In a sermon preached in 1538, Martin Luther observed, "Whoever comes to faith can only say that the Holy Spirit comes when and where and to whom He pleases at the time He pleases. He comes when and where He pleases and also gives a person as many gifts as He pleases" (WLS § 2057). As people in whom the Spirit dwells, we have the joy of discovering special gifts of God in one another and in ourselves as well. May that mutual discovering and celebrating be truly God pleasing in every way!

WOMEN'S SERVICE GUILD: LWML MITES MISSION GRANTS – \$50,000 was collected for Hope and Healing Hub of Downtown Lincoln, Nebraska. They provide Christian counseling services. There is more information posted on the Fellowship Hall bulletin board. The Lutheran Women Missionary League's goal is to raise \$2,100,000 for 21 Mission grants. So far 10 of the 21 Mission Grants have been paid in full. The two other grants that have been paid are Water and the Word for rural schools in Kenya-\$80,000 and God's Word Changes Everything (Lutheran Bible Translators) for \$95,000.
