IMPORTANT SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR CHURCH

These guidelines have been temporarily implemented to make our church environment safer.

1. Pews should have 3 people per pew - one on each end and one in the middle, or two on one end (husband/ wife, etc.) and one on the other end. If there is a family group, they may all be seated in the same pew. PLEASE WORK WITH US ON THIS.
2. In case the sanctuary becomes filled, please find a seat in the fellowship hall or balcony.
3. We will not take the offering during the service. Place your envelope in the offering plate located in the narthex or in the fellowship hall.

BULLETINS, SERMONS AND LIVE WORSHIP: Bulletins and sermons are available for viewing and download on our website. A live stream of worship services is available on our Facebook page. HOME COMMUNION: Christ Lutheran is providing Home Communion Packages with individually wrapped wafers and wine cups. These packages are to be distributed to those who are institutionalized or remain at home on Sundays. Your help getting these packages out is needed. Talk to Pastor if you'd like to help.

CONCORDIA MINISTRIES: Celebrating Concordia's 140th Anniversary: Glimpses of the 1800s Journal entries:

June 27, 1898 – I've planted a total of about 400 celery, 800 red beets, 650 kohlrabi, 830 tomatoes and 1,800 cabbage plants.

April 10, 1899 – Mr. W. C. Meyer and son were here and brought the gas lighting. They didn't have something, so his son had to come back the next day.

April 11, 1899 – The gas illumination is fine.

May 1, 1899 – 150 arborvitae [evergreen trees] and 225 Japanese quince [flowering shrubs] arrived.

May 2, 1899 – Began to plant corn. Warm and dry.

May 30, 1899 – Planted 441 beets, 112 cabbages and 161 tomatoes.
