

### **Women's Service Guild**

**ALTAR GUILD** – Have you noticed that the altar paraments have changed? Some of the women in the congregation change them as the church seasons change or on special occasions. They also set up for Communion. Contact Ruth Hirko if you would like to be part of the Altar Guild.

**HELPING HANDS** – If you have attended a special church function, church dinners or other events and wondered how the Fellowship Hall was turned into an enjoyable eating area, or prepared for a funeral luncheon, thank the women and men who helped to make it happened.

**QUILTING** – If you have ever wondered what happened to the material, sheets, mattress pads that you and other people may have donated, come to quilting on Tuesdays, April 9 and 23, 2019 at 9 a. m. and find out. It is easy to do. If you have ever sewn a button or laced a shoe, “in and out and tie two knots” is all you have to do.

STAMPS – People complain that postage is going up. That little postage stamp along with other postage stamps enable the Lutheran Women Missionary League to raise funds so that the Canadian Bible Society can purchase Bibles for prisoners. Funds are also used to give Bibles to people in their native language.

TELEPHONE COMMITTEE – Stevie Wonder has a song called, “I just called to say I love you.” Well, Barb Mitchell at the church office or Rosalie Filler would “love” to hear if you or a congregational member have moved, changed your phone number or got a new e-mail address. This enables the church to update the church phone directory and notify people for funerals and newsletter mailings, etc.

ALTAR FLOWERS – Celebrate a loved one's birthday, anniversary or in memory of a loved one, graduation, etc. The flowers cost \$30. If you want to share a date, an extra vase is now \$20. The flower chart is on the Narthex bulletin board. Please make payment the day the flowers are put on the altar or in advance. Put your check or money in an envelope marked “altar flowers” and give it to Kathy Sourbeer.

MITE BOXES - There is a saying, “good things come in small packages.” There are “small packages” also known as Mite boxes on the shelf in the narthex. From Oct. 2018 to February 2019 \$112.08 was collected and \$179.16 was collected from the Mitey Muffins Mites. A total of \$291.24. This money is used to fund district and national mission grants. You can read more about the mission grants in the Lutheran Woman's Quarterly. They are on the table in the library near the entrance to the Fellowship Hall.

RECYCLING – There is a bin in the library for recyclable items such as I-pads, cell phones, kindles, computer ink cartridges, etc. The Lutheran Women Missionary League is able to receive money from these items for various mission grants.
