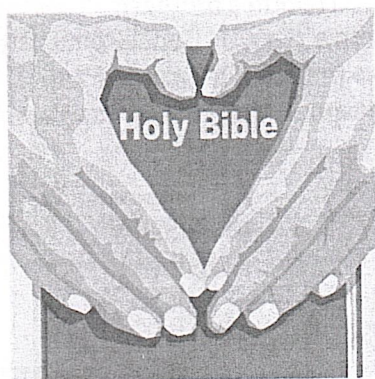
FLOWERS: There are many Sundays open for August and some in September if you would like to sign up. The flower chart is located in the Narthex.

It is time to set aside our daily activities to let God put us in our place as His friends, followers, and family.
