ALL SAINTS SUNDAY: The LCMS observes the day by commemorating all Christians, especially those who have died in the faith, on the first Sunday of November. The service often includes remembering the names of the faithful departed from the past year, sometimes with a bell tolled for each name. The day is a combination of acknowledging grief over death and rejoicing in the hope of the resurrection. The actual day is November 1.
